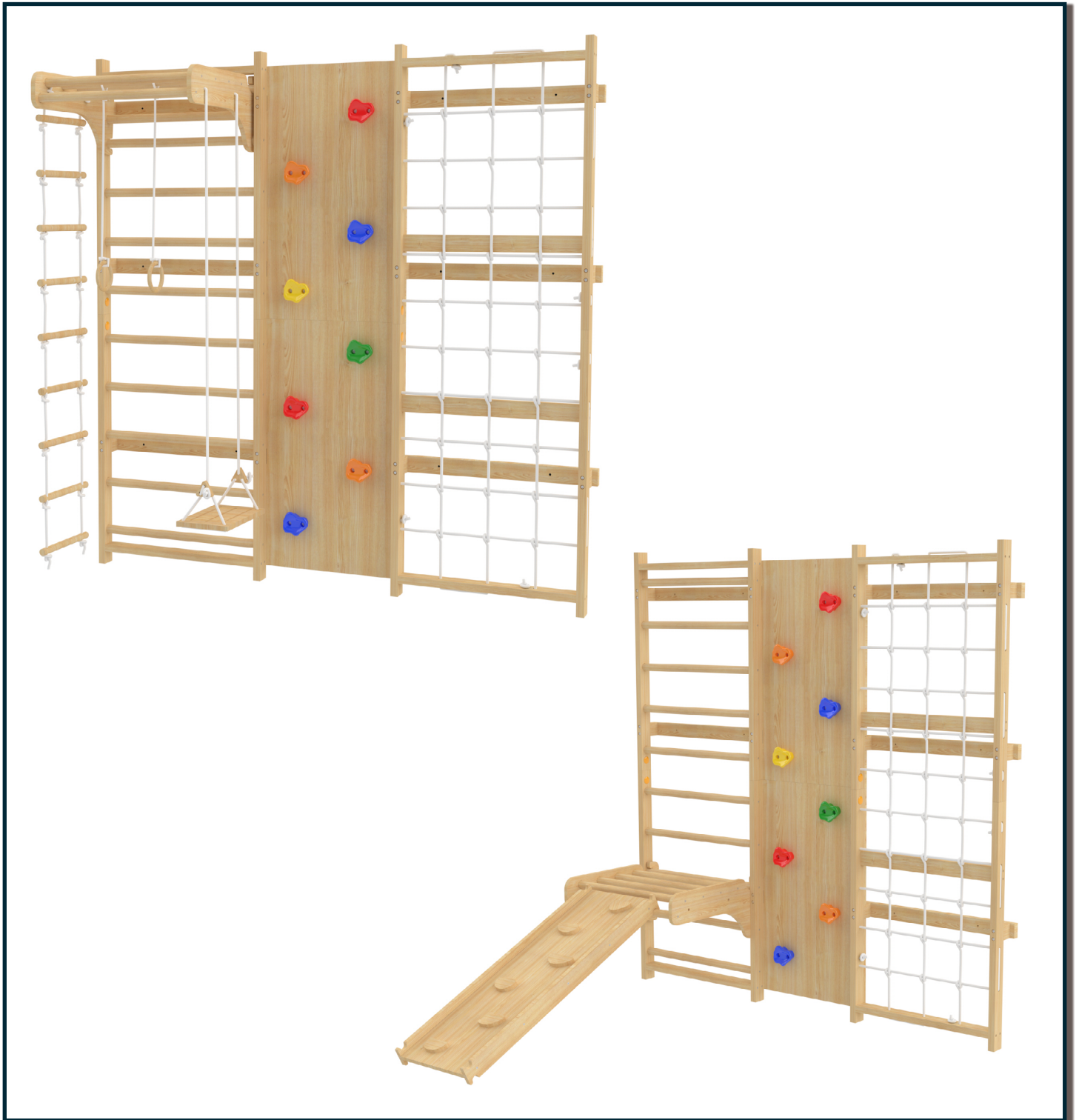

## **OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS**

1. An adult should always supervise use of this product by children of all ages.
2. Maximum weight per user: 220 lbs (100kg)
3. Instruct children not to attach items to the playground equipment that are not specifically designed for use with the equipment (examples: ropes, clothesline, pet leashes, cables and chain, etc) as they may cause a strangulation hazard or any other hazard.
4. Never allow children to use the equipment in a manner other than intended.

## **MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS**

1. Inspect the product periodically for loose or damaged components. **Tighten bolts if need.**
2. Check all connections and bolts for tightness at least twice monthly during the usage.
3. Check all coverings and bolts for sharp edges.

### **Please Ensure:**

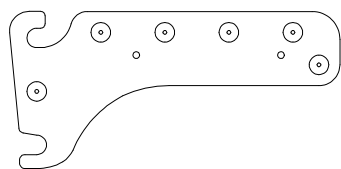
1. You are assembling with at least two people to ensure that all sides and parts are leveled.

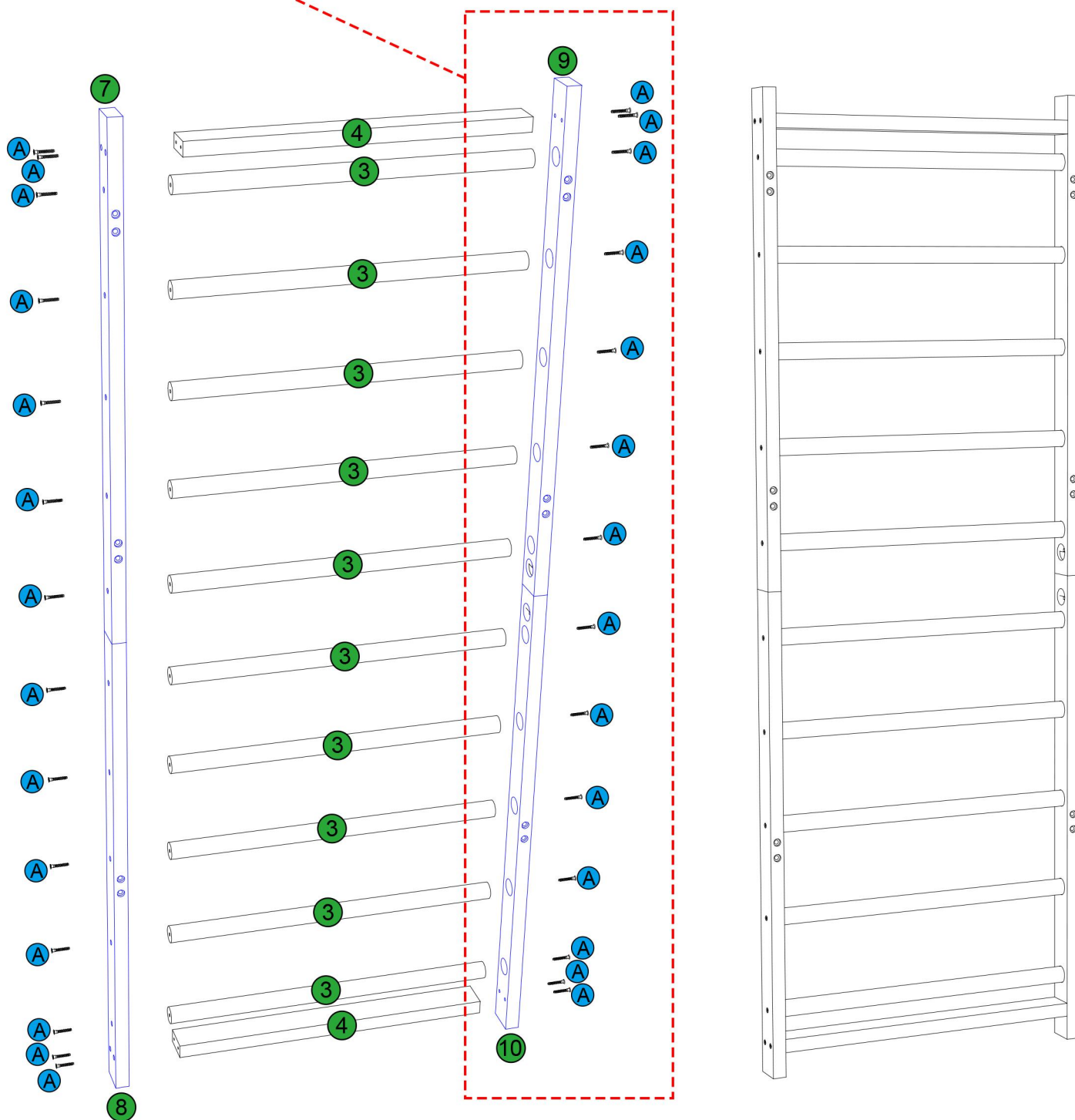
Note: Insert parts **C** and **F** into the holes. Then attach part **D** through **C**. Lastly, screw **E** onto **C**



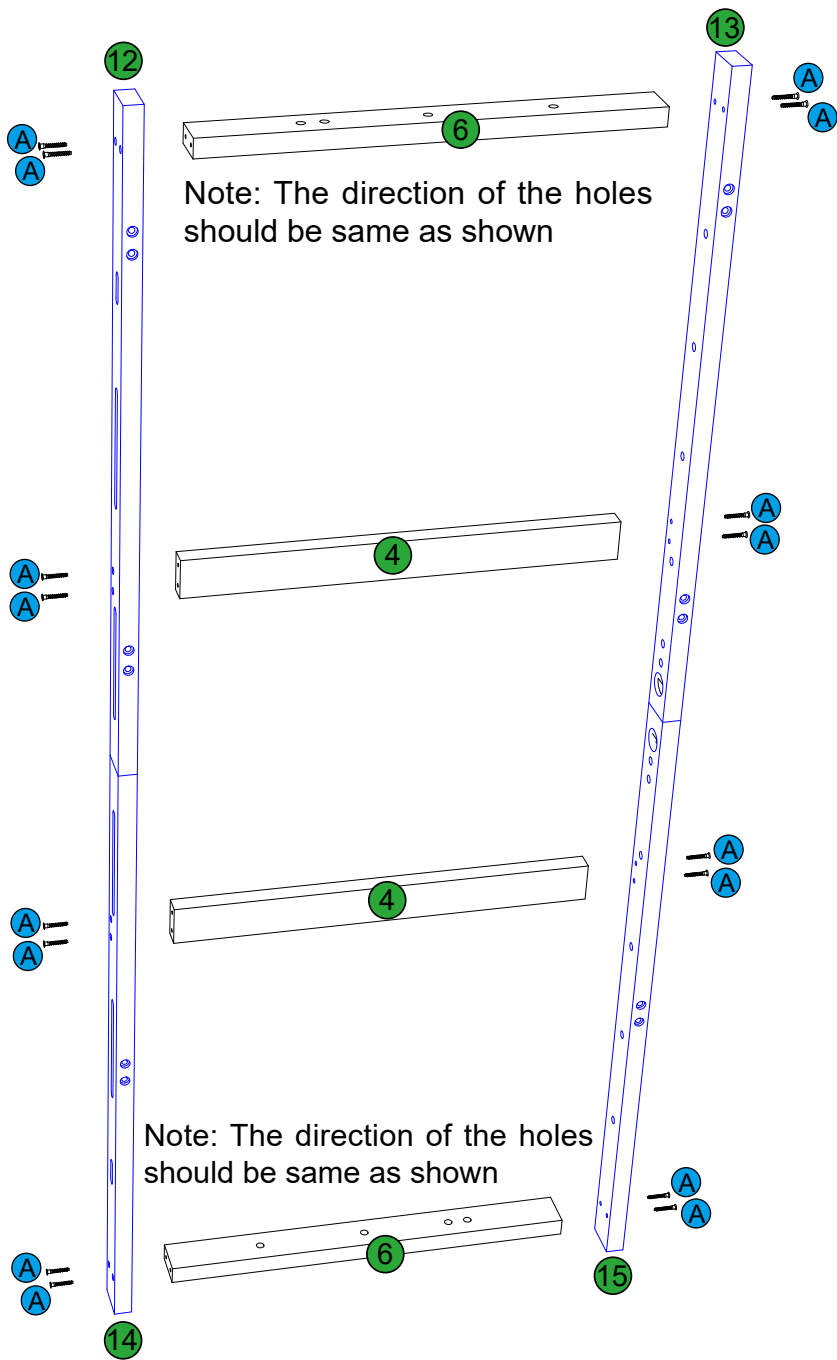

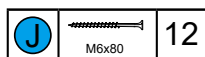
Note that the positions of Section 08-1 and Section 08-2 climbing rocks must be consistent with the instructions as shown.

Note: Use a studfinder and mark the wall where the center of the studs are. Studs are typically 16" apart. Measure the distance between your studs to confirm, Mark, level, and predrill holes in the wall to attach parts **17** with screws **J**
